- 29 **Côtes du Rhône Nature**, Domaine Perrin, 2011/12, Rhône, France
Made in a supple spicy Syrah style. This juicy and effortlessly-delicious wine has the Perrin family fingerprints all over it and the grapes have been grown organically. (C) 14% vol
